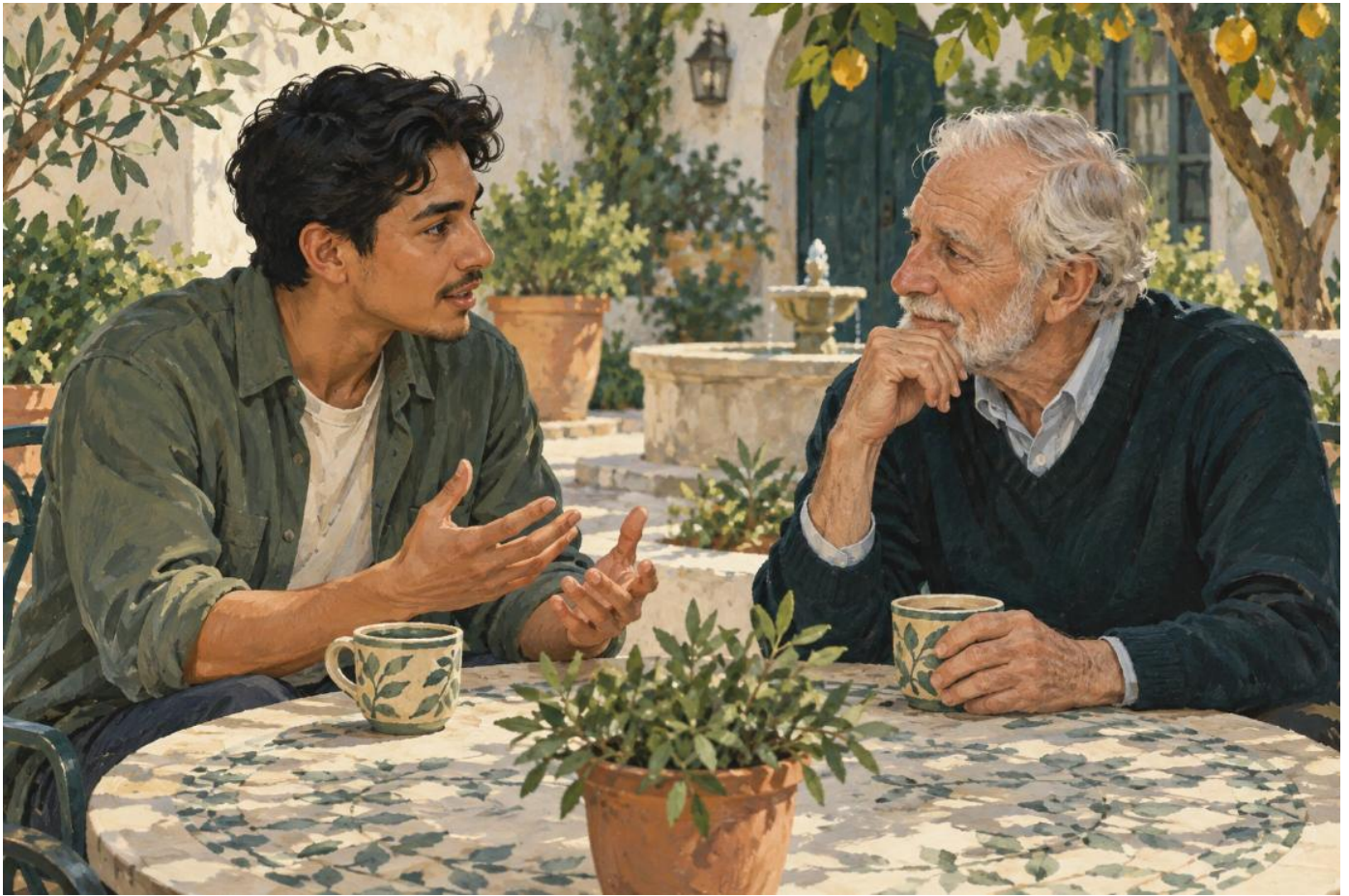

THE DISCIPLINE AND DISRUPTION OF YOUR MIND

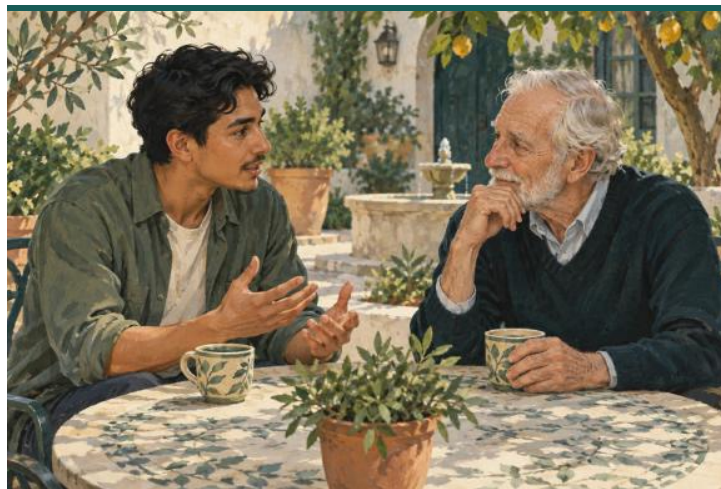
YOU THINK IN STRUCTURES, NOT SLOGANS

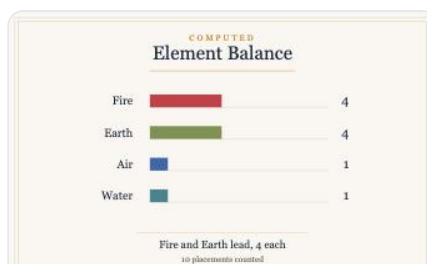

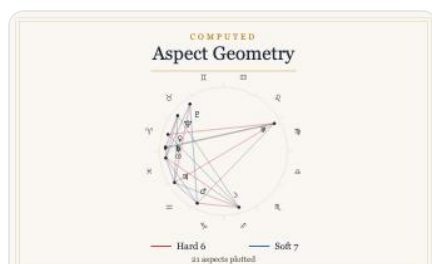
